## NOTES FROM THE VILLAGE AGENT

### Priority Services Register

Just a thought in light of a recent incident which left 1300 people in Nether Stowey and Cannington without gas for several hours. Though Wales and West Utilities handled the situation extremely well on this occasion and did their best to ensure everyone was taken care of, I thought it would be useful to remind you that your energy suppliers keep a priority register of people who are vulnerable, through age, illness, disability, hearing or sight impairment called the Priority Services Register (PSR)



If you're on the PSR, you could get:

- advance notice if your supply is going to be interrupted (though obviously not if the event is unplanned as in our recent experience)
- priority reconnection if your supply is interrupted
- alternative facilities for cooking and heating if your supply is interrupted
- free advice on being more energy-efficient
- extra help to use your meter or appliances
- protection from cold callers with a password protection scheme to keep you safe and plenty more.

If you switch you must register again with your new supplier.
